person and Estate of John W Penn

late of said county, deceased, should not be granted to Robert A Penn

To all to Whom these Presents May Come--Greeting:

KNOW YE, That W. Robert G. Penn as
Principal, and C. Barber & John Horton
as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto
the County Judge of the county of Dallas, in the sum of One
Thousand Dollars, for the payment of which,
well and truly to be made unto the said County Judge, we bind ourselves, our heirs, execu-
tors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents. Signed with
our hands, and sealed with our seals, the seals being scrolls, the 25th day of
October A. D. 1869

The Condition of the above obligation is such, That whereas the above
bound Robert G. Penn has been appointed
Guardian of the Penn and Estate of John W Penn
minor heir of Mrs A Penn deceased
Now, if the said Robert G Penn shall well and truly
perform all the duties required of him under said appointment, then this obliga-
tion shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect
