State of Texas Know all men by these presents
 Dallas County that J. H. Smith as
 principal and James Horton, and J. C. Hawpe
 as Sureties are held and firmly bound
 unto the Chief Justice of Dallas County in the sum
 of Four Thousand Dollars for the payment of which
 well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our
 heirs Executors & Administrators, Jointly and
 severally firmly by these presents, signed & sealed
 using scruples for seals this 28th day of February AD 1834
 The Conditions of the above obligation are such that
 whereas the above bounden J. H. Smith has been appoin-
 = ted by the Chief Justice of Dallas County Guardian
 of the Person & Estate of ^{an} Minor Henry Cygusian
 Hargreaves Minor Heir of Mary Hargreaves deceased
 Now if the said John H. Smith shall well and
 truly perform & discharge all the duties required
 of him by Law under said Appointment; then
 this obligation shall be null and void otherwise
 to be and remain in full force & virtue in Law -
