Your petitioner Jane Wim who  
resides in the County of Dallas and  
State of Texas respectfully represents  
that heretofore to wit on the  
day of AD 187 John  
Allen Wim, the husband of your  
petitioner departed this life intestate  
leaving three minor children  
to wit Allen R Wim, John E Wim  
and Minnie Lee Wim all of whom  
are minors under the age of fourteen  
years; that your petitioner is the  
mother of said minors that said  
minors are entitled to a portion  
of the estate of Allen Wim deceased  
late of Blount County now  
the State of Alabama of the  
probable value of Five Hundred  
Dollars; that said minors have no  
other estate than that above  
mentioned that said minors  
have no legal guardian of their
