Citizen of said County and State by letter this
last inst set on or about the 1st day of March
1862 that there is due and owing to said Lyree
on judgment rendered by the District Court of
Dallas County Texas Feb'y 1860 the sum of
\$195⁴⁰ with interest at the rate of 12 per cent
from said date
