Beard, administrator of the estate of Mr.  
Bangdall - deceased*

in the town of Dallas, on the last Monday in March 1816,  
then and there to show cause, if any why he should not be re-  
quired to make a final exhibit & close said  
Administration as required by Law.

And have you then and there this writ. herein fail not, but due return make as required  
by law.
