town of Dallas, on the last Monday in November, 1859, then and there to show
cause, if any, why *You should not be required to return to*
this court and exhibit a writing of the condition
of said lands estate--
And have you then there this writ. Herein fail not, but due return make as required by law.

widow of John & Nancy Moon, minors & spes

successors in office in the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars
for the payment of which sum we will and truly to be made and
bind ourselves our Heirs Executors and Administrators
severally and jointly firmly by these presents sealed with our
seals and dated this 3rd day of May AD 1847
Whereas the said Mary Moon has this day been by the
Probate Court for the County and State aforesaid appointed
Guardian of Jesse, Mary Martha, and Nancy Ellen Moon
3rd of the ^{infant} Children and Heirs of Jesse Moon late of said
County Deceased.

Now the conditions of the above and foregoing bond
are such that if the above bounden Mary Moon shall
well and truly and faithfully perform and discharge her
several duties and trusts committed to her as such
Guardian aforesaid according to Law and obey all orders of said Court
that may be entered in the premises there and in that case
the above and foregoing obligation to be null and void else
to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law.






