To all to whom these Presents may come--Greeting:

Know Ye, That Anthony Walton as
principal and William M. Tarrant and Liston Applegate
as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto
the Chief Justice of the county of Dallas in the sum of
Five hundred
Dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made unto the said Chief
Justice, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and sever-
ally, firmly by these presents. Signed with our hands, and sealed with our seals,
the seals being scrolls, the Twenty ninth day of January
A. D. 1863

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH That whereas the above
bound Anthony Walton has been appointed
Administrator of the Estate of Henry Walton deceased;
Now, if the said Anthony Walton shall well and truly
perform all the duties required of him under said appointment, then this obligation
shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

The undersigned, who resides in Dallas County &
State of Texas, would respectfully represent that
on or about the 12th day of October 1862, Henry
Walton late of the County and State aforesaid, departs
this life intestate, that said dec^d has due and
owing to him from the C. S. Government, pay for
his services, as a soldier in Capt Thomas' Company
in the 19th Regt Texa Cavalry, about one thousand
and fifty or sixty Dollars, and that dec^d is
indebted to petitioners in the sum of one hundred
and thirty dollars for a horse which said dec^d
rode into the service. The petitioners has no relatives
in this State known to petitioners, He therefore prays
for Letters of Administration, on said estate be granted
to petitioners; and as in duty bound he will
ever pray—
