That I, James H. Mathis a resi-
dent of Dallas County, Texas respectfully represent that
my father William H. Mathis reported his life intellec-
tual, July 28th, 1878 at his residence in the County and State a-
forenamed having an estate in said County real and per-
sonal, that the real property is of the probable value of Four
Thousands one hundred and forty dollars and the personal
of the probable value of Two thousand two hundred dollars
that there are growing crops and stock liable to loss
and that it is necessary to take some action that
said deceased has nothing to him and was intellec-
tual at the time of his death the exact or approximate
amount of his personal property is unable to state that he is over
Twenty one years of age and an heir of said deceased
and that the interests of said estate begin the appointment
of a temporary administrator whereupon petition
