 of Dallas to the probable value of two thousand dollars
 your petitioner further says that the accompanying paper
 marked B. contains a full fair and complete inventory
 and appraisement of the Community property of petitioner
 and her said husband at the time of his death and
 she prays that the same be taken and Recorded as in
 cases of administration and that your Honorable Court
 grant her the Right to manage control and dispose
 of said Community property both Real and personal in
 such manner as may seem best for the interest of said
 estate and in swing and being swid with regard to the same
 in the same manner as during the lifetime of her said
 husband and as in duty Bound your petitioner will
