You are hereby notified, to be and appear before the County Court of Dallas County, in the State of Texas, at the next term thereof, to be held for probate and other like purposes, at Dallas in said county, at the Court House thereof, on the last Monday in *Aug* instant, (the same being the *31* day thereof,) then and there to show cause, if any you have, why Letters of *Administration* upon the Estate of *Burrell Wilks* late of said county, deceased, should not be granted to *Henry Law* who has this day filed with me *his* application in terms of law, praying that the same may then and there be done. This *19th* day of *August* A. D. 1868.
