using Scravels for Seals this 3rd day of April A.D. 1853

The Creation of this obligation is such, that whereas

Guardian of the Estate of the minor E. Crockett,
McKenzie ———— now if the said J.M. Crockett,
shall well and truly perform all the duties required
of him by Law under said appointment, then this
obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to remain
in full force and effect,
