The State of Texas know all men by these presents
 County of Dallas that we Charles G. Newton
 as principal & Jas. A. Smith & John Howell
 as Securities are held & firmly bound unto
 the Chief Justice of Dallas County & to his
 successors in office in the penal sum of nine
 hundred & eighty dollars for the payment of which
 well and truly to be made we hereby bind our
 selves our heirs Executors & Administrators
 jointly & severally firmly by these presents
 signed & sealed (using scrawls for seals)
 this 29th day of March A.D. 1855.

The Conditions of the above Bond is such
 that, whereas the said Charles G. Newton has
 this day returned to the County Court of said County
 a schedule of the Community property of his
 deceased Wife & his own Property at the death
 of his said Wife, amounting to 480 dollars
 four hundred and eighty dollars, Now therefore
 if the said Char^s G. Newton shall well & truly
 comply with an act of the Legislature of the
 State of Texas approved August 26th 1857 Supplemental
 to an act of March 13th 1848, entitled an act
 better defining the marital rights of Parties,
 in regard to said Community property, then
 this Bond to be null & void otherwise to be
 and remain in full force & effect in law
