las, and his successors in office, in the sum of *Fifteen Hundred* Dollars;
conditioned that the above bound *Minnie Danstbor*
as survivor of the Community Estate of *herself* and deceased *Harry*
R. Danstbor will faithfully administer such Community Estate,
and pay over one-half the surplus thereof after the payment of the debts with which
the whole of such property is properly chargeable, to such person or persons as shall
be entitled to receive the same.
