KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, John Chiesa, of the County of Dallas, in the State of Texas, being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

FIRST: I direct that all my just debts shall be paid.

SECOND: I devise and bequeath to my beloved wife, Ida Chiesa, all the estate, right, title, and interest, in possession, reversion or remainder, which at the time of my death I shall have of, in or to, any lands, tenements and hereditaments, and the rents charged upon or issuing out of them, and any personal property, and any other property whatever, be it community or separate property, and wherever situate: to have and to hold the same, it being all the property and estate that I may have at the time of my death, to her, the said Ida Chiesa and her heirs in fee simple.

THIRD: I constitute and appoint my said wife, Ida Chiesa, sole executrix of this my last will and testament, and direct that no security shall be required of her as such executrix.

FOURTH: I direct that no other action shall be had in the County Court in relation to the settlement of my estate than the probating and recording of this will and the return of an inventory, appraisement and list of claims of my estate.
