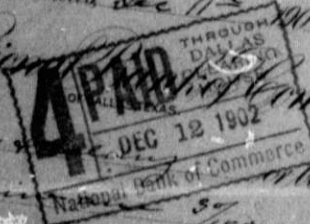

McConnell is the only child of your petitioner which said minor lives with at the home of your petitioner in the County and City of Dallas and State of Texas; that your petitioner is over 21 years of age and is not disqualified to act as guardian of said minor and from her relations to said minor is entitled thereto; that the said minor, Julia D.
