Now comes C. D. Smith a bonafide citizen and resident of Dallas County Texas, and shows to the Court that Arta May Johnson a girl 8 years of age, and William J. Johnson, a boy 6 years old, are minors residing in Dallas County Texas that their father Dr. H. J. Johnson the last surviving parent departed this life intestate in said County and State, on the 21 day of March 1901; that said minors are entitled to an estate situated in Dallas County Texas consisting of real and personal property of the probable value of over thousand dollars; that said minors are without a guardian of their persons, or of their said estate, and that it is necessary that a guardian of their persons and estate be appointed.

Your petitioner would further show that said minors have no relatives within the State of Texas, nor elsewhere, so far as petitioner is informed, who desire to be appointed guardian of said minors; that they have a paternal uncle who resides in Checotah Indian Dy, viz; L. A. Johnson, who has waived all right he may have to such appointment in favor of this applicant; that petitioner is not disqualified to act as such guardian and is a proper person therefor;

Wherefore, petitioner prays that due notice of this application be given as required by law, and that you final hearing hereof be be appointed Guardian of the persons and estate of said above named minors, and for such other and further orders as to the court may seem proper, and he will ever pray, etc.
