Now comes Fannie A. Wallace and files this, her written Application to be appointed administrator of the community estate of her deceased husband T.N. Wallace and herself, and to be invested with the exclusive management, control and disposition of said community estate, and for grounds hereof, she states:

1. That her said husband T.N. Wallace, died in the City and County of Dallas and State of Texas on November 7th, 1909.
2. That he left three children surviving him who are still living, and who are also children of applicant, their names being Lulu May, Ethel and Paul Wallace, Lulu May and Ethel being girls, and Paul being a boy; that Lulu May is of the age of fourteen years, Ethel of the age of eight years, and Paul of the age of five years, and that each of said children reside with applicant in the City and County of Dallas, and State of Texas.
3. That there is a community estate between her deceased husband and herself, consisting of an equity in the house and lot occupied by her and her said children.
4. That applicant resides in, and all of said community estate is situated in, Dallas County, Texas.
5. Wherefore applicant prays for the appointment of appraisers to appraise such estate, and she prays for general relief.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, F.A.Wallace as principal, and _____ and _____ as sureties, are held and firmly bound unto Kenneth Force, County Judge of Dallas County, Texas, and his successors in office, in the sum of One Thousand dollars, for the payment of which sum, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, and firmly by these presents signed by us, dated this 31st, day of August 1900.

WHEREAS, on the day of August 1900, F.A.Wallace filed in the County Court of Dallas County, Texas, an application to be appointed as administrator of the community estate of herself and deceased husband T.N.Wallace, and the court having duly and legally appointed the appraisers of said estate, and an inventory and an appraisalment of said estate having been returned into Court. Now, the condition of the above bond is such that if the said F.A.Wallace will faithfully administer such community estate and pay over one half the surplus thereof, after the payments of the debt with which the whole of such property is properly chargeable, to such person or persons as shall be entitled to receive the same, then, in this case, the above bond to be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and effect.
