This day came on to be heard the application of Mrs. M. C. Fisher for the probate of a certain instrument now produced in open court and purporting and alleged to be the last will and testament of W.F.Fisher, deceased.

And said application and the evidence thereon being heard, and it appearing to the court that due and legal notice of said application has been given and no objection thereto offered, And it further appearing to the court from the written testimony of Mrs. E.E. Mills one of the subscribing witnesses to said will that said W.F.Fisher died in Dallas County, Texas, on the 18th day of Oct. 1900; that he executed said instrument now produced in open Court in the presence of said subscribing witnesses on the 3rd day of Oct., 1900, and declared the same to be his last will and testament; that at the time of the execution of said will as aforesaid, said testator was over the age of 21 years and of sound mind and that each of said subscribing witnesses, to-wit: E.E.Mills and E.L.Fisher, H.B.Gray, and H.E.Mills were, at the time, over the age of 14 years; and that said will was never revoked by said testator; that said witnesses subscribed said will in the presence of and at the request of said testator and in the presence of each other.

It is considered by the Court that said instrument be, and the same is now here adjudged to be the last will and testament of said W.R.Fisher, dec'd., and that said will and the application for the probate thereof and all the testimony in this case be recorded in the minutes of this court. It is further ordered that Mrs. M.C.Fisher be and she is hereby appointed Executrix of said will without bond, and that no further action of the court be had herein except the approving of an inventory and appraisement of said estate, as in said will provided, and that the Clerk do issue to said Mrs. M.C.Fisher, letters testamentary herein when she has taken and subscribed the oath required by law. It is further ordered by the Court that J.P.Reeler, H.O.Chenoweth and Monroe Ferguson be and they are hereby appointed appraisers to appraise the estate of said decedent.
