To the Honorable County Court of said County:-

Your Petitioner, Edward R. Farnell, shows that Joseph G. Field died on the 4th day of July, 1874, at Dallas, in the County of Dallas, and State of Texas; that said Joseph G. Field died without leaving any Will; that he owned, at his death, real and personal estate of the estimated value of Ten Thousand Dollars. That at the time of his death, he owed debts amounting to over Seven Hundred Dollars, and that said debts, at the date of the filing of this Application are yet unpaid, and are owing by said estate. That said Joseph G. Field, at the time of his death, resided in the County of Dallas, State of Texas. That Applicant is entitled to the Administration of said Estate, and is a creditor of said estate. That no Bond has been given for Applicant's debt. That the nature of Applicant's debt is as follows: On the 8th day of December, 1876, Thomas F. Farnell recovered a judgment in the County Court of Dallas County for the sum of \$543⁰⁰, against H. L. Ray, Ben Long, James E. Bartley and G. C. Seydel. That said judgment was appealed to the Court of Appeals at Austin Texas; that said Joseph G. Field was of party on the Appeal Bond in said case, and that
