ESTATE OF MINNIE MITCHELL, DECEASED.

IN THE COUNTY COURT, OF DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS-This the \_\_\_ day of  
January, A.D.1908-

To the Honorable County Court of said County:-

Now comes your petitioner, Jno.S.Mitchell, who resides in  
Dallas County, Texas, the husband of Minnie Mitchell, deceased,  
and would respectfully show to the Court that his said wife,  
Minnie Mitchell, died on or about the 3rd. day of January, 1908  
at Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas.

That the said Minnie Mitchell left surviving her the following  
children, to-wit:- Bonnelynn Mitchell ~~MINNIE~~ a girl 18 years  
of age, and Augustus Mitchell, a boy 4 years of age, both  
of whom now reside with your petitioner in Dallas, Dallas County,  
Texas, at 77 Jefferson St. in said City.

That there is a community estate between the said Minnie Mitchel  
and myself.

That the said deceased died intestate, and was, at the time  
of her death a resident of Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas, that  
there is no Real Estate in said Dallam County, Texas, belonging  
to the said estate, but that all the real property belonging  
therein is now located in the City of Dallas, County of Dallas,  
and State of Texas, and that a part of the personal estate of  
the said Minnie Mitchell and myself is now located in the City  
of Dallas, and County of Dallas, and State of Texas, and a part  
thereof located in Dalhart, Dallam County, Texas.

Wherefore your petitioner asks the court to appoint three  
appraisers to appraise the estate as in other administrations.
