Burke County Judge of Dallas County Texas, and his successors in office in the sum of Five Hundred & Thirty four ⁵⁰/₁₀₀ Dollars - conditioned as follows, Whereas the said A. J. Hughes has filed an Inventory ^{and appraisement} of the Community property of himself and his deceased wife Thyrsa Jane Hughes, to the end that he may have the control management and right to dispose of the same, nor if the said A. J. Hughes shall faithfully administer said Community estate and pay over one half the surplus thereof after paying off the debts with which said Community estate is properly charged to such person or persons as shall be entitled to receive the same then and in that event this bond is to be null and
