                                  §     KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:  
COUNTY OF DALLAS     §

That I, Calvin N. Hanna, of the County of Dallas and State of Texas, being of sound mind and disposing memory, do make and publish this my last will and testament, hereby revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

1. I direct that all my just debts shall be paid, and that the legacies hereinafter given shall after the payment of my debts be paid out of my estate.

2. I give to each of my brothers J.M.Hanna, T.W.Hanna and W.A.C.Hanna the sum of One dollar (\$1.00) each to be paid to them as soon after my decease as conveniently may be done.

3. I give to my sister-in-law Mrs. Lillie P. Hanna all of my property both real and personal, save and except the above bequest of One Dollar each to my three brothers, and save and except my Pistol and Shot Gun which I hereby give and bequeath to my brother W.A.C.Hanna.

4. I hereby constitute and appoint my said sister-in-law Mrs. Lillie P. Hanna my sole executrix of this my last will and testament, and hereby direct and request that she be not required to execute any bond as such executrix, and that she have the sole and exclusive conduct and management and disbursement of my estate, and that no further action be taken by the Probate Court than is necessary under the law to the proof and establishment of this my last will and testament, and the returning and filing in said Probate Court of an inventory and appraisement of all my estate both real and personal.
