Applicant would respectfully shew to the Court;

That he is the father of Laura Belle, Allene and Ruth Werk girl children of applicant and Lula A Werk, now deceased; said children being of the ages 10 years, 7 years and 1 year and reside with applicant in Dallas County Texas.

That said minors are the only heirs at law of the said Lula A Werk, deceased, who died intestate in Dallas County Texas on the 11th day of February 1901, leaving an estate of the probable value of about three thousand dollars, located in Dallas County Texas. That said minors are legatees under the last will and testament of J. S. and Mary W Jehnster deceased, and as such inherited about 80 acres of land located on Cedar Springs Branch about 3 miles north of the City of Dallas Texas in Dallas County, said land being of the probable value of six thousand dollars.

That as such legatees, they have an interest in the said Jehnster estate amounting to about one thousand dollars, which has not been partitioned, which said interest they inherit from the said estate through their mother.

That it is necessary that a guardian of the person and estate of said minors be appointed, that they may be raised and educated in a manner befitting their circumstances.
