Notes to the Financial Statements

NOTE 1: Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

Entity

In 1989, the 71st Legislature established the Department of Information Resources (DIR) through the Information Resources Management Act [TEX. GOV'T. CODE, Chapter 2054]. DIR is an agency of the State of Texas and its financial records comply with state statutes and regulations. This includes compliance with the Texas Comptroller of Public Accounts' Reporting Requirements for state agencies.

DIR is an executive agency governed by a seven member voting board appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Two groups each composed of three ex-officio members serve on the board on a rotating basis.

The Legislature charged the DIR with the mission to provide leadership in and coordination of information resources management within the state government. Toward this goal, DIR is committed to developing and implementing innovative management strategies for the efficient, effective and accountable use of information technology in state government. The department, in alliance with representatives from government and industry, identifies major information resources issues facing the state, performs analytical research, and establishes policies for the statewide implementation of technology.

The following financial statements have been prepared to conform with Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP) as prescribed by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board (GASB).

Due to the statewide requirements embedded in Governmental Accounting Standards Board Statement No. 34, Basic Financial Statements – and Management's Discussion and Analysis – for State and Local Governments, the Comptroller of Public Accounts does not require the accompanying annual financial report to comply with all the requirements in this statement. The financial report will be considered for audit by the State Auditor as part of the audit of the State of Texas Comprehensive Annual Financial Report; therefore, an opinion has not been expressed on the financial statements and related information contained in this report.

<u>Blended Component Units</u>: No component units have been identified which should have been blended into an appropriated fund.

Fund Structure

The accompanying financial statements are presented on the basis of funds, each of which is considered a separate accounting entity.

Governmental Fund Types & Government-wide Adjustment Fund Types

General Fund: The general fund is the principal operating fund used to account for most of the state's general activities. It accounts for all the financial resources except those accounted for in other funds.

Fiduciary Fund Types

Fiduciary funds account for assets held by the state in a trustee capacity or as an agent for individuals, private organizations, other governmental units, and/or other funds. When assets are held under the terms of a formal trust agreement, either a pension trust fund, or a private purpose trust fund is used.

Agency Funds: Agency funds are used to account for assets the government holds on behalf of others in a purely custodial capacity. Agency funds involve only the receipt, temporary investment, and remittance of fiduciary resources to individuals, private organizations, or other governments.

Basis of Accounting

The basis of accounting determines when revenues and expenditures or expenses are recognized in the accounts reported in the financial statements. The accounting and financial reporting treatment applied to a fund is determined by its measurement focus.

Governmental fund types that build the fund financial statements are accounted for using the modified accrual method basis of accounting. Under the modified accrual basis, revenues are recognized in the period in which they become both measurable and available to finance operations of the fiscal year or liquidate liabilities existing at fiscal year end. The State of Texas considers receivables collected within sixty days after year-end to be available and recognizes them as revenues of the current year for Fund Financial Statements prepared on the modified accrual basis. Expenditures and other uses of financial resources are recognized when the related liability is incurred.

Governmental adjustment fund types that will build the government-wide financial statements are accounted for using the full accrual basis of accounting. This includes capital assets, accumulated depreciation, unpaid Employee Compensable leave, the unmatured debt service (principal and interest) on general long-term liabilities, long-term capital leases, and long-term claims and judgments and full accrual revenues and expenses. The activity will be recognized in these fund types.

Budgets and Budgetary Accounting

The budget is prepared biennially and represents appropriations authorized by the legislature and approved by the Governor (the General Appropriations Act).

Unencumbered appropriations are generally subject to lapse 60 days after the end of the fiscal year for which they were appropriated.

Assets, Liabilities, and Fund Balances/Net Assets

Assets

<u>Cash & Cash Equivalents</u>: Short-term highly liquid investments with an original maturity of three months or less are considered cash equivalents.

Restricted Assets: Restricted assets include monies or other resources restricted by legal or contractual requirements. These assets include proceeds of enterprise fund general obligation and revenue bonds and revenues set aside for statutory or contractual requirements. Assets held in reserve for guaranteed student loan defaults are also included.

<u>Inventories and Prepaid Items</u>: Inventories include both merchandise inventories on hand for sale and consumable inventories. Inventories are valued at cost, generally utilizing the last-in, first-out method. Inventories for governmental fund types are the purchase method accounting. The consumption method of accounting is used to account for inventories and prepaid items that appear in the governmental and proprietary fund types. The cost of these items is expensed when the items are consumed.

<u>Capital Assets</u>: Assets with an initial, individual cost of more than \$5,000 and an estimated useful life in excess of one year should be capitalized. These assets are capitalized at cost or, if not purchased, at appraised fair value as of the date of acquisition. Purchases of assets by governmental funds are reported as expenditures. Depreciation is reported on all "exhaustible" assets. "Inexhaustible" assets such as works of art and historical treasures are not depreciated. Road and highway infrastructure is reported on the modified basis. Assets are depreciated over the estimated useful life of the asset using the straight-line method.

All capital assets acquired by proprietary fund or trust funds are reported at cost or estimated historical cost, if actual historical cost is not available. Donated assets are reported at fair value on the acquisition date. Depreciation is charged to operations over the estimated useful life of each asset, using the straight-line method.

<u>Other Receivables</u>: Other receivables include year-end revenue accruals not included in any other receivable category. This account can appear in governmental and proprietary fund types.

LIABILITIES

<u>Accounts Payable</u>: Accounts Payable represents the liability for the value for assets or services received at the balance sheet date for which payment is pending.

<u>Other Payables</u>: Other payables are the accrual at year-end of expenditure transactions not included in any other payable descriptions. Other payables may be included in either the governmental or proprietary fund types.

Employees' Compensable Leave Balances: Employees' Compensable Leave Balances represent the liability that becomes "due" upon the occurrence of relevant events such as resignations, retirements, and uses of leave balances by the covered employee. Liabilities are reported separately as either current or non-current in the statement of net assets.

FUND BALANCE/NET ASSETS

The difference between fund assets and liabilities is 'Net Assets' on the government-wide, proprietary and fiduciary fund statements, and the 'Fund Balance' is the difference between fund assets and liabilities on the governmental fund statements.

Fund Balance Components: Fund balances for governmental funds are classified as nonspendable, restricted, committed, assigned or unassigned in the fund financial statements.

- Nonspendable fund balance includes amounts not available to be spent because they are either (1) not in spendable form or (2) legally or contractually required to be maintained intact.
- Restricted fund balance includes those resources that have constraints placed on their use through external parties or by law through constitutional provisions.
- Committed fund balance can be used only for specific purposes pursuant to constraints imposed by a formal action of the Texas Legislature, the state's highest level of decision making authority.
- Assigned fund balance includes amounts constrained by the state's intent to be
 used for specific purposes, but are neither restricted nor committed. Intent is
 expressed by (1) the Texas Legislature or (2) a body (for example, a budget or
 finance committee) or official to which the governing body has delegated the
 authority to assign amounts to be used for specific purposes.
- Unassigned fund balance is the residual classification for the general fund.
 This classification represents fund balance that was not assigned to other funds and was not restricted, committed or assigned to specific purposes within the general fund.

<u>Invested In Capital Assets</u>, Net Of Related Debt: Invested in capital assets, net of related debt consists of capital assets, net of accumulated depreciation and reduced by outstanding balances for bond, notes and other debt that are attributed to the acquisition, construction or improvement of those assets.

<u>Restricted Net Assets:</u> Restricted net assets result when constraints placed on net asset use are either externally imposed by creditors, grantors, contributors and the like or imposed by law through constitutional provisions or enabling legislation.

<u>Unrestricted Net Assets:</u> Unrestricted net assets consist of net assets that do not meet the definition of the two preceding categories. Unrestricted net assets often have constraints on resources, which are imposed by management but can be removed or modified

INTERFUND ACTIVITIES AND BALANCES

The agency has the following types of transactions between funds:

- (1) Transfers: Legally required transfers that are reported when incurred as "Transfers In" by the recipient fund and as "Transfers Out" by the disbursing fund.
- (2) Reimbursements: Reimbursements are repayments from funds responsible for expenditures or expenses to funds that made the actual payment. Reimbursements of expenditures made by one fund for another are recorded as expenditures in the reimbursing fund and as a reduction of expenditures in the reimbursed fund. Reimbursements are not displayed in the financial statements.

Employees' Compensable Leave

A state employee is entitled to be paid for all unused vacation time accrued, in the event of the employee's resignation, dismissal, or separation from State employment, provided the employee has had continuous employment with the State for six months. Expenditures for accumulated annual leave balances are recognized in the period paid or taken in governmental fund types. Note 15: Contingencies and Commitments

Under Rider 5 of the General Appropriation Act, Texas Department of Information Resources (DIR) has the authority to borrow funds from the Comptroller of Public Accounts. During FY12, \$4 million was borrowed and is included in the amount of the original Legislative Appropriation revenues reported on Exhibit II. This \$4 million loan must be repaid by August 31, 2013.

Note 18: Management Discussion and Analysis

DIR is funded primarily through cost recovery fees charged via interagency contracts and appropriated receipts. DIR earns revenue from the services it provides through its Cooperative Contracts; Communications and Technology Services (CTS); and Data Center Services (DCS) programs. The legislature also appropriates general revenue to DIR to operate the Texas.gov web portal and for costs associated with the State's implementation of the Centralized Accounting and Payroll/Personnel System (CAPPS).

Modifications made to DIR's appropriations for the 2012/13 biennium impose caps on DIR's expenditure authority, require DIR to obtain LBB approval to expend funds in excess of specifically appropriated amounts, and require DIR to report program specific financial information to the LBB and Governor's office.

Senate Bill 1, 82nd Legislature, 1st Called Session, provides the Legislature with the authority to appropriate DIR funds out of the Clearing Fund Account, Telecommunications Revolving Account, and Statewide Technology Account to be used to fund the costs of DIR's non-revenue generating programs. The bill also allows for appropriations from the Clearing Fund Account and the Telecommunications Revolving Account to fund activities included in Texas Government Code Chapter 2054 (Information Resources Management Act).

The amounts reported as total fund balances decreased from \$17.4 million to \$8.4 million from the fiscal year ending August 31, 2011, to the fiscal year ending August 31, 2012, respectively. The decrease is due to several factors including reduced cost recovery fees and rebates issued to customers.

The General Appropriations Act, 82nd Legislature, requires that DIR report costs avoided and/or savings obtained through its cooperative activities and a list of the agencies or units of local government for which the clearing fund account was used during the fiscal year ending August 31, 2012. For the fiscal year ending August 31, 2012, DIR cooperative activities generated approximately \$257.6 million in costs savings for customers of the Cooperative Contracts program. A list of customers who procured goods and services through this program is presented at Addendum 1.

DIR recently concluded the procurement of its TEX-AN NG telecommunication contracts. Negotiated price reductions were approximately 50% for voice services. The exact savings of this procurement will be a function of the purchase volumes.

During the fiscal year ending August 31, 2012, DIR successfully terminated operations under the State's previous DCS contract, and commenced expanded and enhanced services through contracts with three new service providers under a new business model.

DIR performs a key oversight role in the Texas.gov portal with its partner TEXAS NICUSA LLC. For the fiscal year ending August 31, 2012, the portal generated approximately \$32.8 million in general revenue for the State.

Note 23: Extraordinary and Special Items

Pursuant to Article IX, section 18.15 of the General Appropriation Act of the Eighty-second Texas Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, in the event that unexpended and unobligated balances in the DIR Clearing Fund at the end of any fiscal year exceed 10 percent of the total revenue, the portion of the excess over the 10 percent from all funding sources shall be returned to agencies. In addition, in the event that unexpended balances in the Telecommunications Revolving Account at the end of any fiscal year exceed a two month operating reserve, the portion of the excess over the two month operating reserve funded from all funding sources shall be returned to agencies. During fiscal year 2012, DIR recognized a special item expenditure in the Clearing Fund and the Telecommunications Revolving Account of \$4,799,234.54 and \$6,955,074.50, respectively.
