
Elizabeth Herrmichel has filed, in the County Court

that I may possess at the time of my death, and I hereby
conmit the guardianship of all my children, unto my said

be demanded of her as executrix or guardian of this my last
will and testament.

Your petitioner Elizabeth Herrinckel shows to the Court that she resides
in the County of Dallas State of Texas.
That on the 20th day of August 1983 C.W.
Herrinckel who, at and before his death
had his domicile in the County of
Dallas State of Texas died in the County
of Tampico in said state.

That at the time of his death the
said C.W. Herrinckel was seized and
possessed of real and personal proper-
ty of the probable value of \$2000.00
the real part of which said property
consisted of his homestead being
a lot of land in the City of Dallas
in said County of Dallas State of
Texas together with the house thereon
and the personal part of which
said property consisted of the house
hold goods in said house. Your peti-
tioner further says that at the time of
the death of the said C.W. Herrinckel
she left a written will duly ex- -

dated and herewith filed in a
which your petitioner was appointed
as executrix that said Will
herewith deposed left all of
his property to your said petitioner
as his sole heir and request-
ed that no bond or security
should be required of her
as executrix.

Your petitioner further says that
she is not disqualifid from
accepting letters testamentary
that it is necessary that said
will should be probated in order
to perfect petitioner's title in
