That she is the daughter of CW Herrmickel deceased, ^{of the County of Lambada} that her father the said CW Herrmickel departed this life on the 20th day of August 1883 in the County of Lambada, that she is familiar with the handwriting of the deceased and that the will which is attached to the application in this cause is wholly in the hand writing and was written by her father the said CW Herrmickel deceased that at the time of his death he resided in Dallas County Texas with his family - That the will which is attached to the application in this case was not found until some time during the month of June 1885 when affiant found it in an old trunk among some papers of her father the said C. W. Herrmickel. That it is very necessary that her mother Elizabeth Herrmickel should have the said will probated in being a necessary link in her chain of title, and that it is no fault of the said Mrs Elizabeth Herrmickel that this application was not made sooner. that I may possess at the time of my death, and I hereby
commit the guardianship of all my children, unto my said
wife.

And I request and demand that no bond or surety shall
be demanded of her as executrix or guardian of this my last
will and testament.

Your petitioner Elizabeth Herrmichel shows to the Court that she resides in the County of Dallas State of Texas. That on the 20th day of August 1993 C. W. Herrmichel who at and before his death had his domicile in the County of Dallas State of Texas died in the County of Tarrant in said state.

That at the time of his death the said C. W. Herrmichel was seized and possessed of real and personal property of the probable value of \$2000⁰⁰ the real part of which said property consisted of his homestead being a lot of land in the City of Dallas in said County of Dallas State of Texas together with the house thereon and the personal part of which said property consisted of the household goods in said house. Your petitioner further says that at the time of the death of the said C. W. Herrmichel he left a written will duly exe-

cutted and herewith filed in ~~the~~
 which your petitioner was appointed
 executrix. That said Mrs. Merrin
 deceased left all of his property to your said petitioner
 as his sole heir and requested
 that no bond or surety should be required of her
 as executrix.

Your petitioner further says that she is not disqualified from accepting letters testamentary. That it is necessary that said will should be probated in order to perfect petitioner's title in and to the said property. Said will being a necessary minimum in said title. That the reason that said will has not been probated sooner is because the same was not found until the month of June 1986 - at which time said will was found by accident and that your petitioner was not aware of her duties or rights in relation to the same.
