


and Testament of Crawford Trees deceased coming  
on to be heard 2<sup>nd</sup> day of March AD 1859  
The following evidence was adduced on the hearing

1<sup>st</sup> The Will of the Said Crawford Trees was read  
which is here on file and attached to said appli-  
cation

2<sup>nd</sup> The citation issued by the Clerk with the  
Sheriff's return - Showing that the same was served  
in the manner required by law and for the

Cause

Being duly sworn deposed  
and say upon their oaths that they and each  
one of them were acquainted with Crawford  
Trees during his lifetime and that said  
Crawford Trees was a married man and  
was over twenty one years of age on the 30<sup>th</sup>  
day of August AD 1854

That on said day said Crawford Trees requested  
them and each one of them to sign their names  
as witnesses to his the said Crawford Trees  
Will which has been read and is on file  
attached to the application herein made  
That they saw said Crawford Trees sign by  
making his mark his name to said Will  
- and that he stated in their presence that  
the same was his Will, and they and each

one of them <sup>in the presence of each other and in the presence of said trees</sup> signed their names to the same  
as witnesses at the request of the said Crawford  
Trees - Affiants further say that said Crawford  
Trees was of perfectly sound mind and of  
<sup>and disposing</sup> good memory at the time (30<sup>th</sup> day of August AD  
1884) he signed said will, and perfectly ac-  
quainted with what he was doing -

Witnesses further say that said Crawford Trees  
died 31<sup>st</sup> day of January 1889 in Dallas County  
Texas, and that his principal property worth  
about Thirty (\$30,000) Thousand Dollars lies  
in Dallas County Texas

Affiants further swear that the decedent  
executed said will with all the solemnities  
and formalities required by law and  
that and that said it was his last will  
and testament - Affiants further say that  
they nor either one of them have any  
knowledge of the said will or any part  
thereof ever having been revoked since  
its execution and that they nor either one  
of them - know of no codicil or change  
of any kind having been made to said  
will since the date of the same

The State of Texas In The County Court - February Term  
County of Dallas Ad 1889

To Hon. E G Brown Judge of the County Court  
of Dallas County Texas

Your petitioner Anna Minerva Tress a resident citizen of Dallas County Texas would respectfully represent unto your Honor that she is the surviving widow of Crawford Tress who died at his residence in said County on the 31<sup>st</sup> day of January AD 1889 - That Said decedent in his life time to wit on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of August AD 1884 who was then of sound mind made a Will, revoking all former wills made by him, and executed the same with the formalities and solemnities required by law - which said Will was never revoked, and is hereto attached marked "Exhibit A" and made a part of this petition, and that by the terms of said Will he (decedent) devised and bequeathed to petitioner absolutely and in fee simple all his (decedent's) Estate both Real Personal and mixed with the condition or proviso stipulated. That if any part of said Estate so devised and bequeathed to her should remain on hand unsold or undispersed of by her at her (petitioner's) death then and in that case such remainder shall be divided among his (the Testator's) children according to the terms named in said Will. It is further stipulated in said Will that your petitioner be the Sole Executrix of said last Will and Testament, and that no Bond be

required of her (petitioner) and that no action be had or taken by the County Court Sitting for Probate in regard to Said last Will and Testament, except that Said Executrix furnish the Said Court with an Inventory and Appraisement of Said property and effects, and the Probate of Said Will.

Petitioner would further represent that the property Real Personal and mixed derived and bequeathed is one half of the Community property of herself and her deceased husband (Crawford Trees) and is of the probatable value of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30000.00).

Petitioner further represents that she is in no way disqualified from acting as such Executrix, as by Said appointment she is made - Therefore the premises considered, petitioner prays that Citation issue as the law directs, and that upon a hearing hereof at the next regular term of your Honors Court - that Said Will be admitted to probate, and that Appraisers be appointed, and that an Inventory and Appraisement of Said Estate be recorded as the provisions of Said Will and the law directs - and that no further action be had or taken in reference to Said Estate in your Honors Court - other than the Probate of Said Will.

of the uncertainty of life and the certainty of death, and  
wishing to dispose of my worldly goods, to take effect  
after my death, do publish this my last Will  
and Testament, hereby revoking all former wills  
by me at any time heretofore made.

Item - 1<sup>st</sup> It is my will and desire that all my just debts  
and funeral expenses be first paid out of my  
Estate.

Item - 2<sup>nd</sup> I give devise and bequeath to my beloved  
Anna Milleria Prees all the property both Real &  
Personal and Mixed of which I shall die Seized  
or possessed of, or to which I shall be entitled to  
at the time of my decease to be owned and held  
by her absolutely in fee Simple, with power to  
Bargain Sell and Convey and dispose of as she  
pleases, without any hindrance or restraint - and  
if any of Said Estate be devised and bequeathed  
to her, should remain in her hands undispersed

to her at her death - Then it is my will that  
my children now living shall Share Said re-  
mainder as follows:

I Then it is my will that my Son David Prees shall  
have four thirty fifth (435) of Said remainder in  
fee Simple without remainder to any one

II And that my Son Phillip William Prees shall  
have a like share of four Thirty fifth (435) of Said  
remainder in fee Simple without remainder to any one

III And that my Son Samuel Henry Price Shall have a like share of four Thirty fifth<sup>(45)</sup> of Said remainder in fee simple without remainder to any one

IV. And that my Son Granford Price Shall have a like share of four thirty fifth<sup>(45)</sup> of Said remainder in fee simple without remainder to any one

V. And that my Son Robert E Lee Price Shall have

a like share of four Thirty fifth<sup>(45)</sup> of Said remainder in fee simple without remainder to any one

VI And that my Son George Washington Price Shall have a like share with his brothers of four Thirty fifth<sup>(45)</sup> of Said remainder in fee simple without remainder to any one

VII And it is my will that my daughter Beatrice Penn Shall have a like share of four Thirty fifth<sup>(45)</sup> of Said remainder for her own separate use benefit and behoof for and during her natural life with remainder to her children living and in being at the time of my death

VIII And that my daughter Catherine Ramsey Shall have a share of three Thirty fifth<sup>(35)</sup> of Said remainder for her own Separate use benefit and behoof for and during her natural life with remainder to her children living and in being at the time of my death

IX And that my daughter Texanna ~~Kist~~ Shall have a share of two Thirty fifth<sup>(25)</sup> of Said remainder for her own Separate use benefit and behoof for and during her natural life with remainder to her children living and in being at the time of any death

X And that my daughter Mary Ellen Butner Shall
