in good health and sound mind
disposing mind and memory do make
and publish this my last will and
testament hereby revoking all former
wills by me at any time heretofore
made

First, I direct that all my just debts
be paid and that the legacies hereafter
given shall after the payment of
my debts be paid out of my estate.
Second I give to my beloved husband
Julian Reverchon all of my property
both real personal and mixed that I
may own and die possessed of.
Third it is my will and desire that
after the death of my said husband
that all of said property real personal
and mixed shall descend to Robert
M. Greenon of the County of Dallas
State of Texas and should he die
without issue then it is my will
and desire that all of the property
I may own and be possessed of at the
time of my ^{death} and owned by said
Greenon and inherited by him from
me shall ~~be~~ descend and be inherited
by "Saint Vincent de Paul" and under
the management of said institution
be spent in Dallas County Texas for
the benefit of the sick Sisters of
that order in Dallas County Texas.
Fourth it is my will and desire that
no further administration be had on

my estate after my death than
the probate of this my last will
