Court, that his wife Roberta Rosser Coke, died
in the City and County of Dallas on August
9th 1888. That she left surviving her three
children, Henry C. Coke Jr, born Nov. 17th 1887
Roberta Rosser Coke, born Dec. 25th 1885; and
Rosser Coke born August 3rd 1888, that all
of said children reside with their father
the petitioner in the City of Dallas.
That there is a community estate between
the said Roberta Rosser Coke &c & your
petitioner, that all of said estate is in Dal-
las County, and that said petitioner and
his deceased wife were at the date of her
death that been for some years prior
themselves residents of said County & that peti-
tioner and his said children still reside
in said County. That said community es-
tate is heavily indebted. Wherefore petitioner
prays that appraisers be appointed to ap-
