KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That, I, Lou S. Baldwin, wife of William H. Baldwin, being of sound mind and disposing memory and realizing life's uncertainty, do make, publish and proclaim this instrument to be my last will and testiment hereby revoking all other wills of every character heretofore, at any time, by me made.

First. I give unto my daughter Dixle Fry all my silverware and direct that the same be delivered to her by my Executor.

Second. I give to my daughters Una May Baldwin, Dottie Baldwin, Etta Baldwin and Nora Baldwin all my household and kitchen furniture and direct that the same be used for their benefit by my Executor.

Third. I give and bequeath unto my daughters Una May, Dottie, Etta and Nora Baldwin subject to the trust thereon reposed and vested in my Executor hereof, in equal portions to each, five hundred and fifty four acres of land on Cedar Lake in Brazoria County, Texas, about 13 miles from the town of Brazoria, and being the same land willed to me by Mrs. Jane White Baldwin.

Fourth.I give to my son James D. Baldwin all my right, title and interest in and to II, I80,000 square varas of land patented to the heirs of Floyd Jordan, patent No. 61 of Vol. 16 dated Aug. 7th 1868 by authority of Certificate 212 Abstract 167, situated in the Counties of Wichita and Archer in this State and being the same land willed to me by Mrs. Jane White Baldwin.

Fifth. I give and bequeath unto my Executor hereof James D. Baldwin in trust for my dau ghters named in paragraph "Third" hereof but without personal interest to him and for the purposes and trusts here specified, the bow acres of land discharged and mentioned in said "Third" paragraph, to have hold and dispose of the same for the uses and benefits of said daughters who are all minors, as here directed. And my said Executor

shall have and he is hereby given the power to sell—said land whenever he shall deem it to the best interests of my said daughters to do so, and to use the proceeds thereof or so much as may be necessary for the support and education of my said daughters; and to reinvest such proceeds and the residue thereof, from time to time, as he may think best for the advantage of said funds and said children.

My executor shall not charge anything for his services in managing said property and funds, and he shall when any of my said daughters shall have reached the age of twenty three years or marries pay to and turn over to said child, her distributive share in such property as it then exists; until such last named event or events happen the said estate shall be kept together as a whole and used for the benefit of all of said children collect-
