Ida M. Hearn, who resides at the county of Robinson, in the State of Texas, and who brings this suit as the guardian of the person of William W. Leonard a minor, and as his next best friend, on his behalf respectfully shows to your Honor: That the said William W. Leonard is now of the age of more than fourteen years; that he is an orphan and the son of Jackson L. Leonard deceased, and his wife Mittie Leonard; that the said Mrs. Leonard died in the county of Dallas on the day of January 1882, leaving surviving her, the said J. L. Leonard and her son, W. W. Leonard; that she died intestate; that Jackson L. Leonard died in the county of Dallas on the day of June 1883, leaving a will which has been duly probated; that by the said will of the said W. W. Leonard, your petitioner, Ida M. Hearn was appointed guardian of the person of W. W. Leonard, and that S. J. Adams, who resides at the county of Dallas, was appointed guardian of the estate of the said W. W. Leonard, bequeathed and willed to him by his father, Jackson L. Leonard. Your petitioner shows that at the date of the death of Mrs. Mittie Leonard, mother of her ward, the said J. L. Leonard and his said wife were possessed of a large and valuable estate in the State of Texas, a large portion of which was held in common between the said J. L. Leonard and S. J. Adams, who were then partners conducting a banking business in the city of Dallas under the firm name of Adams and Leonard; that at the date of the death of the said Mrs. Mittie Leonard, the community estate of herself and her said husband J. L. Leonard, was of great value, to wit: of the value of \$250,000.00; that there were no community debts owing by the said Jackson L. Leonard at the date of the death of his wife, or if any at all, of inconsiderable sum; that no administration was ever opened on the estate of the said Mrs. Mittie Leonard, nor did the said J. L. Leonard, her surviving husband ever in any wise qualify under the Statute so as to authorize him to dispose of any portion of the community property belonging to the mother of the said W. W. Leonard and Jackson L. Leonard, his father; that on the death of the said Jackson L. Leonard, S. J. Adams, the defendant herein, who was appointed by the will of the said Jackson L. Leonard, the guardian of the estate of W. W. Leonard, took possession of all the property of the said W. W. Leonard, including that inherited by him from his mother Mrs. Mittie Leonard, as well as that bequeathed and devised to him by his father, Jackson L. Leonard just prior to his death; that after the death of the said Jackson L. Leonard, S. J. Adams received into his hands from sundry life insurance companies, the sum of \$36,200.00, which belonged to the said W. W. Leonard, and was the proceeds of sundry insurances upon the life of the said Jackson L. Leonard, his father, and that for this amount of money the said S. J. Adams issued to W. W. Leonard a certificate, and thereupon took the said money and applied it to his own use; that the annexed exhibit "A" contains a partial list of the real estate belonging to Jackson L. Leonard and his wife Mittie Leonard before her decease, and held in common between the said J. L. Leonard and S. J. Adams; that the same amounts in value to \$182,100.00; that the annexed exhibit of stocks, bonds and cash, amounting to \$230,698.38, was also held in common by the said Adams and Leonard, one half thereof belonging to the community estate of the said Jackson L. Leonard and the mother of the said W. W. Leonard, at the date of her decease, amounting in the aggregate to \$421,798.38. Your petitioner shows that since the said S. J. Adams took possession of the property of her ward W. W. Leonard, from the estate of his mother and bequeathed to him by the will of his father, he has squandered, misapplied the said sum of \$36,200.00 arising from insurance on the life of the said Jackson L. Leonard and bequeathed to the said W. W. Leonard, and in addition

to this, the said Adams, on the 19th day of November 1884, made a conveyance by deed of assignment, of all the property belonging to her ward W.W. Leonard, descended to him from his mother's estate, as well as that bequeathed to him by his father, to one W.M. Philipp of the city of Dallas Texas; that the conveyance of the said property by the said Adams, was made for his own use and benefit, with utter disregard for the rights of her ward W.W. Leonard; that all the shares, stocks, mortgagess, bonds, notes, mortgages and other property of every description in the hands of the said Adams as guardian of the said W.W. Leonard, have been squandered, miss-applied and attempted to be conveyed by the said Adams, in utter dis-regard of the rights of W.W. Leonard, and for the sole use and benefit of the said Adams. Your petitioner shows that the said Adams is now insolvent and utterly unable to respond to her, the said guardian, in any sum. The premises considered, your petitioner prays that the said Adams be removed by order of this court from his trust and office of guardian, and that some other person, competent and qualified, be appointed by this Honorable Court, to be the guardian of the estate of the said W.W. Leonard to the end that his property rights may be protected and preserved, in-so-far as can be, under the circumstances. Your petitioner prays for notice to the said Adams, and for all such further orders and decrees as may be necessary to be made in the premises.






