out of sound mind and disposing memory,
do make and declare this to be my last
will and testament, in manner fol-
lowing, to-wit:

First, my family consists of my
beloved wife, Maria F. Little; my son,
John G. Little of Memphis, Arkansas;
and my daughter, Marjorie L. Hooker,
of Lexington, Kentucky.

Second, I desire that all my just
debts be paid.

Third, I desire my wife, Maria F.
Little to dispose of any or all of my
personal or real estate as she may
think proper.

Fourth, I nominate and appoint
as sole executrix of this my last will
and testament, my wife, Maria F.
Little and desire that she be not re-
quired to give bond.

hundred and eighty eight.
