It having been shown to me that Louis R.Mohrhardt, late a resident citizen of the county of Dallas, in the State of Texas, died in Dallas county on the 8th day of November, A.D.1888, intestate, and leaving personal property of the value of \$1,675.00, (sixteen hundred and seventy five dollars,) the same being money deposited in The City National Bank of Dallas, Texas, to the credit of said Louis R.Mohrhardt, and that the interest of said estate requires the immediate appointment of a Temporary Administrator; it is ordered that Frank A.Mohrhardt, of Dallas county, State of Texas, be and he is hereby appointed Temporary Administrator of the Retate of the said Louis R.Mohrhardt, dec'd, with authority to take possession of all the property of said estate, as well as to receive said fund from said City National Bank, and receipt therefor, and to do and perform all such other and further acts as may be necessary for the preservation of said estate.

It is further ordered that the said Frank A.Mohrhardt give bond in the sum of thirty three hundred and fifty (\$8350.) dollars, and take the oath as required by law, and that this order shall be recorded in the probate minutes of the County Court of Dallas county, and this appointment shall cease to be of force on the day designated for taking up probate business at the first term of the County Court of said county, held next after the date of this order.
