This day came on to be heard the final account of O.P.Scott Temporary Administrator of the Estate of Elizabeth Durgin Deceased herein before filed May 2 1902.

It appearing to the Court that said Administrator has duly performed all duties required of him by law and the orders of this Court appointing him and that said account is in all things true and correct, said account is hereby approved, and i temporary administrator is ordered to turn over the estate to the heirs of said decedent. And it further appearing to the Court that no further administration on said estate is necessary, it is ordered that the same be and the same is hereby closed.

Upon turning over said estate to the heirs of said decedent the said O.P.Scott and his bondsmen are discharged.

Temporary Administrator is allowed the sum of Fifty Dollars for his services herein and the further sum of Twenty Five Dollars for attorneys fees to be retained out of the monies now in his hands, and shall pay out of the monies on hand the costs of court.
