children of any child of mine, the share  
to which this Spans would have  
been entitled as above set out.
- 2<sup>d</sup> That the shares of each legatee respect-  
ively shall be charged with all the  
advances made to them by me heretofore  
or at any time here after, that the  
share of my son Joe Skellon shall be  
charged with the sum of Fifty Dollars  
and interest as shown by his note  
held by me.
3. I direct that a credit of the sum of
