



That on the 26th Day of October A.D. 1863 the County of Dallas County Court issued to the Heirs of said deceased a Certificate for 320 acres of Land. That the same is probably worth Twenty five or One Hundred Dollars and that said deceased has no relatives in the State of Texas.
Your Petitioner would therefore pray your Honor Court to be administrator of said deceased's estate and do such other matters and things in relation to said estate as may be right and just and as in duty bound he will ever pray.




