Your petitioner Anna Struck, respectfully represents that she is the lawful wife of Henry Struck and that they reside in Dallas County

Texas; that the said Henry Struck is a male person of <sup>45</sup> years of age and is the owner of the following described tracts of land, situated in Dallas County, Texas, to wit:

First tract: being a part of the Robert Sloan one third League

survey, about 13 miles S. 35 from the city of Dallas, beginning at an elm tree marked as fore and aft tree in the south line of said Sloan survey being the East corner of 118 73/100 acres of Waters and Lowry, thence with the south line of said Sloan survey No. 60 E 507 <sup>varas, thence N. 30 W 769 Varas, a Stake</sup> varas a stake in the N.W. boundary line of said Sloan survey a honey locust 16 in. dia. brs S. 53 E. 84 1/2 varas, thence with said Sloan N.W. line S. W. 507 varas to the north corner of said Waters and Lowry tract a stake, locust 1 inch diam. brs N. 60 E 2 varas, thence with said Waters and Lowry N.E. line S. 30 E. 789 varas to the place of beginning, containing (69) sixty nine acres; also the following tract, being the <sup>remnant of the 42 acres of timbered land deeded to T.J. Snow, beginning at the N.W. corner of said Snow survey thence East 415 8/10 varas to a stake, thence south 475 2/10 vara to a stake, thence west 415 8/10 varas to a stake, thence North 475 2/10 varas to the place of beginning, being the same land conveyed to me by August Mueller on the 26th day of September 1893 and recorded in Vol. 166-page 536. Records of Deeds etc of Dallas County, Texas.

Coombs headright survey, thence West 209 1/2 vrs to the North East corner of a tract deeded by F.M.Hanks to Sarah J.Perry, April 18th 1878, recorded Book T page 70 Record of deeds, Dallas County, thence S. 2 1/2 West 168 vrs to a stake on south line of a 12 acre tract, deeded to F.M.Hanks by B.M.Bradford as Guardian etc, (recorded in Vol. 9 page 475 ) Thence E. 201 8/10 vrs to a stake in the East line of said 12 acres tract, thence North 5 East 1.38 vrs to the beginning, and being lots Nos. Your petitioner further shows, that she and the said Henry Struck are the owners of the following described personal property, which is also community property; situated in Dallas County, Texas, to-wit: household and kitchen furniture of the probable value of \$1,000; two horses of the probable value of \$100.00; one carriage of the probable value \$85.00; two buggies of the probable value of \$30.00 each; one vendors lien note in the sum of \$200.00 and one vendors lien note in the sum of \$100.00 :

That said property constitutes all of the estate now owned and possessed by the said Henry Struck; that said Henry Struck is a person of unsound mind and has been for a long time prior hereto; that said estate is likely to be wasted and destroyed so long as it remains under the control and care of the said Henry Struck, and that it is necessary that there be appointed a guardian of his said estate, in order to administer, control and care for same properly and economically; that your petitioner is not disqualified under the law from being appointed and acting as such guardian and that under the law, this Court is vested with jurisdiction to appoint a guardian herein, as herein-after prayed for.

Wherefore applicant Mrs. Anna Struck prays that she be appointed guardian of the estate of the said Henry Struck and for other other relief etc.
