 Ten thousand and fifty dollars
 for the payment of which bill
 and truly to be made we bind
 ourselves our heirs and legal rep-
 resentatives jointly and severally
 firmly by these presents.

The Condition of the above obligation
 is such that, whereas Eliza J.
 Parish surviving widow of
 Henry J. Parish, decd., has filed
 with the said James M. Law, clerk
 of the District Court of Dallas
 County, an inventory and ap-
 praisal of the Community prop-
 erty of the said Henry J. Parish
 decd., and he self, and has taken
 the oaths and ~~power~~ of disposi-
 tion of said property, now if
 the said E. J. Parish shall faith-
 fully administer the said Com-

minority, estate, and pay over one
half of the surplus after the
payment of the debts with which
the whole is properly chargeable.
to such person or persons as shall
be entitled to receive it, then and
in that event this obligation is
to be null and void, otherwise
to remain in full force and
effect.
