 successors in office in the sum of Five thousand  
 (\$5,000) hundred and ten Dollars for the payment of  
 which well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our  
 heirs Executors administrators jointly severally jointly  
 by these presents signed with our hands this 28<sup>th</sup> day  
 of April 1863.

The condition of the above obligation is such that  
 whereas the said above bounden Sally Reinhardt  
 surviving widow of Louis Reinhardt deceased  
 has filed in my office her Inventory & appraisement  
 of the property belonging to the estate of said dead  
 & whereas the said Sally Reinhardt has taken the  
 Oath of administration of the said property in  
 accordance with an act entitled "an act supplement-  
 ary to the act of March the 15<sup>th</sup> 1848" entitled "an act  
 defining the marital rights of parties" approved August  
 20<sup>th</sup> 1848 also by the said Sally Reinhardt shall well  
 and truly perform all the duties required of her  
 by said act & also pay all the debts of the said  
 estate then this obligation to be null & void  
 otherwise to be and remain in full force and  
 effect Signed & Sealed as above written
