To the Hon Hardin Hart Judge &c

And now comes E. P. Killebrew Administrator of the estate of Ruth Baxter in said County & presents the within as a true & correct Exhibit of the condition of the said estate at the present time. Said administrator would respectfully state that since the filing of the inventory of said estate that he has divided the personal property set out in said inventory equally among the heirs of said estate, that the said heirs are all of age or have attained to that majority, that he is still in possession of Realty amounting to 230 acres of land including the homestead as set forth in said inventory of the valuation of Twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500⁰⁰) that the said tract of land belongs to three of the heirs all being of age or a majority. He therefore prays the Hon Court to receive & approve his said Exhibit and that he be allowed to make a final Settlement of his administration of said estate & that notice of this application be given as the Law directs & as in duty bound &c
