 we, J. G. Cox as principal and H. Bank  
 dale, Laurie Robertson, & J. S. Ehler  
 as sureties are held and firmly bound  
 unto the County Judge of the County of  
 Dallas, or his successors in office, in  
 the sum of One Thousand Dollars  
 for the payment of which, well and  
 truly to be made unto the said County  
 Judge, we bind ourselves, our heirs, ex  
 ceptants and administrators, jointly  
 and severally, firmly by these presents  
 signed with our hands the day of  
September A.D. 1878; The condition of  
 this obligation is such, that whereas  
 the above named J. G. Cox, has filed his  
 inventory and appraisement of the  
 Community property of Alice Cox de  
 ceased, wife of the said J. G. Cox now  
 if the said J. G. Cox surviving husband  
 of said Alice Cox deceased, will faithful  
 ly administer the same, and pay over  
 one-half of the surplus after the payment  
 of the debts with which the whole is pro  
 perly chargeable, to such person or persons  
 as shall be entitled to receive it, then  
 this obligation shall be well and paid,  
 otherwise to remain of full force and effect




