 in Office in the full sum of Three Thousand Dollars
 for the payment of which sum well and truly to be made
 we bind Ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrators
 severally and Jointly firmly by these presents sealed with
 Our seals and dated this 31st day of May A.D. 1847
 Whereas the said Ellis C. Thomas has this day been by the
 appointed by the Probate Court for the County & State aforesaid Guar-
 dian of Calixton Moon (late Calix Moon) one
 of the Children and Heirs of Esse Moon late of said
 County Dec'd

Now the Conditions of the above and foregoing Bond are
 such that if the above bounden Ellis C. Thomas shall
 well and truly and faithfully perform and discharge his
 several duties and trusts committed to him as such
 Guardians aforesaid according to Law and Obey all orders of
 said Court that may be entered in the Premises, then and in
 that Case the above and foregoing Obligation to be null and
 Void Else to remain in full force and Virtue according to Law
