This cause this day
coming on to be heard upon the final
report of the administrator herein
filed November 28th AD 1887 - and
it appearing to the court that due and
proper notice of the filing of said
report had been given to all parties
interested in said estate by a citation
in form as required by statute issued
by the Clerk of this court - and duly
returned by the Sheriff of Dallas County
Texas - said Sheriff's return showing
that said citation had been duly
and properly published in a newspaper
published in Dallas County Texas -
namely in "the Dallas Daily Times" - for
twenty consecutive days - Sundays excepted
the first day of such publication being
from the 29th day of November AD 1887 -
And the court having now examined
said final report and the vouchers
accompanying the same - and it
appearing to the court that said
report is in all things correct
and that there are no objections or
exception thereto - It is therefore ordered
adjudged and decreed by the court

that said report be and the same is
hereby in all respects approved and
confirmed and ordered spread upon
the minutes of this court which is
accordingly now done said report
being in words and figures as follows
to wit: —

And it further appearing to the court
that the Administrator has paid all
costs of this administration and that
~~there~~ is none of the estate remaining
in his hands — It is therefore ordered
adjudged and decreed by the court
that administration upon the estate
of J. B. Simpson deceased is now
closed — and that Richard Morgan
the Administrator aforesaid estate
is hereby finally discharged from
his trust as such administrator —

Laura L. Simpson shows
that her husband Thomas B. Simpson
died died on the 1st of July 1875
at the City of Dallas, County of Dallas in
the State of Texas, without any will
leaving no Homestead or any real
estate, but leaving personal estate con-
sisting of a Brick Kiln of one hundred
thousand burnt brick of the value
of eight hundred dollars, one horse
of the value of 8 dollars, Two mule
worth \$100 - two carts worth \$20 each & 40
old lumber 15000 feet worth in all
\$75 That the applicant as surviving
wife of said decedent is entitled
to letters of administration. Wherefore
the prays that she be appointed
Administrator of said estate

Now comes Richard Morgan the Administrator of the estate of J.B. Simpson deceased - and submits to the court this his account for final settlement and shows to the court - that the only property of the estate known to this Administrator was the tract of land - containing two and a fraction acres - more particularly described in the Inventory heretofore filed herein - and which was sold by this Administrator for the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars - as reported by him herein in his Report of Sale filed herein April 2nd AD 1881 - and which said sale was subsequently on record April 9th AD 1881 confirmed by this court - This Administrator further shows that the only debt proved against the estate was a judgment against the said J.B. Simpson - for debt and foreclosing the vendor's lien on said land - which said judgment had been transferred to this Administrator and was established as a claim in his favor for the sum of Two Hundred and Eleven + $\frac{95}{100}$ Dollars by an order of this court made on record on November 17th AD 1880 - This Administrator further shows that the proceeds of said sale of said real estate was not equal to the amount of the aforesaid judgment and vendor's lien against said land - and

that this Administrator has applied all of said proceeds of sale - except so much as was necessary to pay the costs of this Administration - to the payment of said judgment - and that there is still a balance due on said judgment - And there is no estate in his hands or known to him -

Wherefore he prays for an order approving this his final account - and final discharging him from his trust and declaring administration on said estate to be closed -
