The State of Texas in Probate Court  
County of Dallas March Term A.D. 1874

To the Chf Justice &c.

Your petitioner E. P. Tillotson a citizen of  
said County would respectfully state to your Hon. that he before  
to wit, on the 27th day of Feb 1870 Ruth Baxter died  
in said County. That at the time of her said death the said  
Ruth was left and possessed of Three hundred and Twenty  
acres of land in said County worth six or Seven dollars  
per acre and also of personal property worth some  
five hundred dollars. Petitioner would further state that  
the said Ruth left no will and that said ~~estate~~ is  
indefinite to some extent and that there are debts due  
& owing to said estate and that he (petitioner) is one of  
the heirs of said Ruth Baxter, she having left no surviving  
husband.

The premises considered petitioner prays that notice  
of this application be given as the Law directs and on  
the hearing hereof he prays that Letters of administra-  
tion on said estate be granted to him and as in duty  
bound he will ever pray.
