On this day came on to be heard the application of William J. Petterton to be appointed Guardian of the Estate of Claude Pagon, and it appearing to the Court that citation has, issued upon said application in the manner and form required by law and that such citation has been served as required by law, more than ten days before the first day of the present term of this Court: and it further appearing to the Court that the said Claude Pagon is a minor, under the age of fourteen years, and that the said William J. Petterton is a suitable person to be appointed the Guardian of said Estate and entitled to be so appointed. It is therefore ordered that the said application be granted and that the said William J. Petterton be and he is hereby appointed guardian of the Estate of the said Minor Claude Pagon upon his giving the bond and security as required by law in the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars conditioned as the law directs, and ~~and it is ordered~~ taking the oath ~~of~~ required by law: And it is ordered that the Clerk of this Court do issue letters of guardianship to said William J. Petterton when he shall have qualified by taking said oath and giving said bond.

It is further ordered that William L. Trigg, James J. Carnes and Paul Turst of Dallas County, Texas, be and they are hereby appointed as appraisers to appraise such estate and return such appraisements to the Court

Your petitioner William J. Patterson, a resident of Dallas
 County, Texas, respectfully represents that there is resident in
 Dallas County, Texas, a minor male child, Claude
 Pagon the son, by a former marriage of your petitioner's
 wife Anna E. Patterson, formerly Anna E. Pagon
 the said minor now being thirteen years
 of age. Your petitioner represents that said minor is
 the owner of an estate of the probable value of Five
 Thousand Dollars, consisting mainly of money and
 shares in action now in the hands of a guardian hereto-
 fore appointed for his estate in the County of Vanderburg,
 in the State of Indiana or under the control and supervision
 of the probate Court of said Vanderburg, County, Indiana.

Your petitioner represents that the said minor has no
 guardian of his estate in the State of Texas; that his father
 is dead and that his mother, the wife of your petitioner
 desires that your petitioner shall be appointed guardian
 of the estate of said minor, and that the said estate may
 be transferred from the State of Indiana, where it now is,
 to the State of Texas, and to Dallas, County.

Wherefore your petitioner prays that, after due pro-
 ceedings had in this Court, he be appointed the Guardian
 of the Estate of said minor, Claude Pagon, in the terms
 of the law.

Know all Men that we William J. Betterton as principal and Samuel J. Adams and W.C. Connor as Sureties, do acknowledge ourselves firmly bound by these presents unto Robert E. Burke, Esquire, County Judge of Dallas County, Texas, and unto his successors in office in the penal sum of Ten Thousand Dollars: the Condition of the foregoing obligation however being as follows, viz: if the said William J. Betterton shall faithfully discharge the duties of Guardian of the Estate of Claude Ragon, a minor, according to law then the said obligation shall be null and void: otherwise it shall remain in full force and effect.
