I have strength so to do, do make this my last will
and testament, hereby revoking all others heretofore by
me made.

Item 1st. I desire and direct, that my body be buried
in a decent and Christian like manner, suitable
to my circumstances and condition in life.

Item 2^d. I desire and direct, that my just debts be
paid without delay, by my executor to be hereafter ap-
pointed.

Item 3^d. I give to my beloved daughter, Mrs. Barbara
Bopp, the sum of five hundred dollars in Cash.

Item 4th. The residue of my property wherever and
whatever it may be, I give, bequeath and devise to my
beloved daughter, Mrs. Anna Kitzli, forever.

Item 5th. I hereby constitute and appoint my trusty and
worthy son-in-law, Henry Kitzli, sole executor of this my
last will and testament.

Item 6th. It is my desire and will that no bond be
required of my said executor and that no action be taken
by the County Court in regard to this my last will
and testament, except to probate the same and to require
of my said executor an inventory of my property and
effects.
