

our seals. the seals being scrawls this the
27 day of January A.D. 1857

The condition of
the above obligation is such that whereas
the above bounden Silas B. Rumyon has been
appointed, Surodign of the estate of his
Minor ^{heirs} by the chief justice of Dallas county
to wit: Jefferson B. Rumyon, Silas S. Rumyon
Asa M. Rumyon, George A. Rumyon, and Absolom
E. Rumyon. Now if the said Silas B. Rumyon
shall well and truly perform all the duties
required of him by law under said appointment
then this obligation shall be null and void,
otherwise to remain in full force and effect
