and Alvina M. Memphis residents of
the County of Dallas and State of Tex
respectfully show to the Court that
on the day of 7-18 John W
Hopkins departed this life in the County
of Dallas and State of Texas testate
leaving his property to his wife Mary
& Hopkins for her use and benefit during
her natural life and at her death to
his children to wit said Alvina M.
Memphis, Lilly M. Hopkins, David
I. Hopkins, Josie Hopkins and Margaret
Hopkins all of his estate both real and personal
that on or about the day of 11-18-94
said Mary & Hopkins intermarried with
one J. B. Reynolds

that on the 3rd day of August A.D.
1895 the said Mary & Reynolds departed
this life in said Co. and State, testate
and left her surviving as her sole heir
at law her husband the said J. B. Reynolds
and her children the said Alvina M.
Memphis, Lilly M. Hopkins, David I.
Hopkins, Josie Hopkins and Margaret
Hopkins and Mary Ida Reynolds

that said Mary & Reynolds was on said 3rd

 are female Minors of the ages of 13 and
 11 years respectively and that your petitioners
 have requested the said R S Hight to
 take the guardianship of the estates
 of said last two Minors

That said R S Hight has agreed to
 accept the guardianship of the said
 Minors and is not disqualified therefrom

That the estates so inherited and derived
 of said Minors is of the aggregate value
 of ^{about} ~~one~~ thousand dollars

Therefore your petitioners pray that due
 notice hereof be given as required by
 law that they be appointed guardian
 of the persons of said Minors and that
 said R S Hight be appointed guardian
 of the estates of said Minors and
 for such other and further orders
 as may be necessary in the premises
