To the Sheriff of Dallas County: Greeting

You are hereby Commanded that you summon David Post a Minor over the age of fourteen years, if to be found in your County, to be and appear before the County Court at the next regular term thereof, to be held for Probate and other like purposes, in and for said County, at the Court-House thereof at Dallas on the next Monday in December instant (the same being the 30<sup>th</sup> day thereof) then and there to choose a guardian for his person and property, or a guardian for the same, without good cause shown will then and there be appointed by the Court.

Herein fail not but make due return of this writ with your action thereon as the law directs.

bound Thos. Vernoy has been appointed  
Guardian of the Estate of David Bast

Now, if the said Thos. Vernoy shall well and truly  
perform all the duties required of him under said appointment, then this obliga-  
tion shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect
