The State of Texas In Probate Court
County of Dallas Jany Term AD 1869

To the Hon. J. E. Combs
Chief Justice of said County

You, therefore, John E. Webb, who is a resident of said County
would respectfully represent that before, to wit, on the 15th day
of August A.D. 1863 his wife Sophie Stubbs departed this
life, that at the time of her said decease, the respective sum
of legal owing in Community property both real, personal and
mixed in said County of the value of one thousand & fifty six
Dollars & fifty Cents, which will more fully appear by reference
to an inventory of said property herewith filed and added to be
taken as a part of this petition. Petitioners would further state
that said Estate has now been administered upon & otherwise take
cognizance by the said Prob. Court, that said Sophie left at the
time of her said decease his heirs, consisting of Branch Stubbs &
other all minors, and that there are many outstanding debts of
said Estate & claims owing to the same.

The premises considered petitioners pray that said inventory
be taken & recorded as in case of administration & to have the
same force & effect in all suits between parties claiming un-
der it. And that said petitioners shall have the right to manage
control & dispose of said Community property both real
and personal in such manner as shall seem to be best
for the interest of said Estate, and of owing & being due
with regard to the same in the same manner as during
the life of his said wife and as on duty bound.
Said Petitioners will ever pray.
